



## WHY IS JULY 1ST KNOWN AS THE "OFFICIAL" MOVING DAY IN CANADA?

Especially in Quebec, July 1st is much more than Canada Day — it's also the day of the big move! Every year, on the same date, thousands of people relocate.

A little history! In 1974, the Quebec government moved lease end dates from May 1st to June 30th.

As a result, July 1st naturally became the big moving day.

What began as a tradition has grown into a unique social phenomenon — today, it's unlike anywhere else in the world!

## **MOVING ON JULY 1ST IN QUEBEC - FUN FACTS**

- Around 200,000 moves take place around July 1st each year in Quebec that's roughly 5% of the population!
- Nearly 70% of residential leases in Quebec still end on June 30th. Even though the rules have changed, the tradition remains firmly rooted.
- Demand for moving trucks triples in the two weeks around July 1st. The consequence? Prices increase by 30% to 100% compared to the rest of the year!
- About 10% of households face challenges finding housing before July 1st, largely because affordable options are limited in many regions.
- In Montreal, around 70,000 households move each year around July 1st. That makes it the moving capital of the world, no less!

- 1 Decide on your moving date.
- Compare 3 to 5 local companies for prices, services, and insurance.
- 3 Secure a moving company (or a moving truck).
- Donate, sell, or throw away what you don't want to take with you.
- Begin packing your boxes weeks ahead of time.
- Update your address and notify Canada Post, utilities and internet providers, and all your subscriptions.
- Prepare a survival kit for moving day and the first few days after your move.
- 8 Ensure parking and easy access at your current and new residence.
- Inspect both properties, take before-and-after photos, note meter readings, and handle keys.
- Leave the home clean for the next tenants or for the landlord's inspection.

## How much does it cost to move on July 1st?

Due to high demand, moving on July 1st is significantly more expensive than at other times of the year.

- **✓** The hourly rate goes up to \$350/hour for 2 movers.
- ✓ The hourly rate goes up to \$500/hour for 3 movers.

Scheduling a move a few days before or after can reduce the cost by almost 50%.

#### **MOVING ON A BUDGET - TIPS**

Moving on July 1st is expensive, but there is always a way to cut costs without compromising on quality.

- Sook in advance
- (\$) Compare multiple quotes
- (\$) Pack your own boxes
- **(\$)** Reduce the number of boxes to move
- **(\$)** Ask friends and family for help
- Move a few days before or after July 1st
